

Crossing for prevention is an event to raise awareness and seek generous financial support from the local communities to the cancer foundations.

After four years, the Aruban athlete and open water swimmer Deaxo Croes will be back in the water on November 19 in. His second swim, "Crossing for Prevention" becomes a solo crossing from the southernmost point from Bonaire, at the dive site Red Slave Huts, to the easternmost point of Curaçao, a distance of about 55 kilometers. The goal is to raise money for the prevention of cancer in Aruba, Bonaire and Curaçao. "I can't imagine a better goal, that was our starting point. It's a great opportunity to contribute to something outside yourself," said Deaxo Croes.

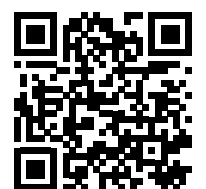

Oranjestad – Aruba Volunteers, an initiative of CEDE Aruba, is a website where nonprofit organizations can easily recruit and retain volunteers for their community related initiatives. Volunteers can find and register for volunteer work all year round through the website ArubaVolunteers.org.

Organizations will have their own digital presence on the website and volunteers interested in a certain vacancy can sign up for a volunteer activity. It is very simple to register on the website, but if help is needed, CEDE Aruba will assist all year round and they also respond to the supply and demand of volunteers, volunteer work and participation of companies in different ways.

A volunteer can also register for the volunteer pool with preferred wishes for volunteer work, so an organization can contact them for a project. By doing

this there is no commitment to anything yet.

Volunteer work and activities can vary from one-time jobs like a beach clean-up, a one-time installation project or helping at a sports event, to repeating projects as reading to clients at an elderly home or helping out with a gardening project organized by a non-profit organization. If a foundation needs a board member, they can also post their vacancy on the platform for example.

With volunteer work you meet new people, you get to know organizations you have never heard of, you contribute to the community, you get a good feeling because you are contributing, and you can learn new skills and grow.

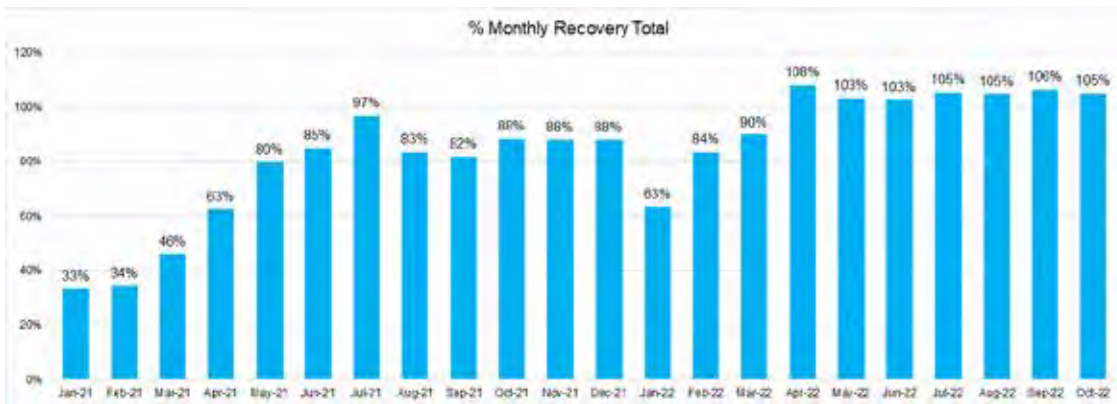

“OPEN WATER SWIMMING MAKES ME FEEL FREE”

In 1988, Roly Bisslik became the first Aruban to cross from Venezuela to Aruba to raise money for Aruba's first Olympic swimming pool. In 2018, thirty years later, Deaxo wanted to commemorate this swimming trip together with four other open water swimmers, Davy Bisslik, Wendy-Kock, Stephan Thijsen and Romar Arendsz.

With their swimming trip 'Crossing for Hope', in which they swam from Venezuela to Aruba, they collected 123,000 Aruban florins for the Wilhelmina Cancer Fund in Aruba. But that swim was not enough for Deaxo, it tasted like more and this time he wanted to involve the other islands of Curaçao and Bonaire as well. Unlike the first swim, the open water swimmer wanted to do a solo trip this time.

"It is harder, but during this process I notice that it has its advantages, it ensures that you develop on a broader level and it also makes you wiser," he explains. "Now I can say it was a good choice because I see the growth in myself, although I admit that I do miss my fellow swimmers. I do most of the training alone, you also miss sparring with other swimmers about your experiences." He now sees the added value of such a solo trip and the growth he is experiencing. "It makes you feel independent and I always wanted to do something that would one day allow me to sit at the same table as the greats in the sport, like Roly Bisslik, and share thoughts about your experiences."

Crossing for Prevention

The name of the swim refers to the previous swimming trip in 2018, but this time Deaxo wanted to focus on cancer prevention. With his action, he wanted Aruba, Bonaire and Curaçao to come together for a good cause. When he saw the impact of preventive screening on people at Fundashon Prevension in Curaçao, he was



deeply impressed. That is why he has linked a fundraising campaign where people on the islands can help with donations to foundations that are actively involved in prevention on all three islands. For Curaçao this became the Fundashon Prevension, also known as the Caribbean Prevention Center, which conducts population screenings on the island for breast cancer, cervical cancer and colon cancer. population screening for cervical cancer and colon cancer.

On Bonaire, it was decided to help the Cancer Fund since funds are already available from the national government for population screening for breast cancer, among other things, he explains.

Going the extra mile

Deaxo always wanted to be the best in sports and always goes the extra mile. As a child he contracted blood poisoning after being vaccinated against meningococcus, which prevented him from lifting his left arm all the way up to this day. "That doesn't hinder my training.

For a long time I didn't want

people to know about this, but now I want to talk about it to show people that you shouldn't let your circumstances stop you from following your passion." Seven years ago he went open water swimming for the first time, when Roly invited Bisslikhem to test open water swimming because it was a nice addition to a free diver



like Deaxo. "After the first game, Roly said: I expect you at the pool on Monday.

And I thought that was a great honor, that's how the training sessions started." In the swimming pool, which is also called 'the lab', he trains three times a week on his condition and his stroke. In the afternoon he is in the gym and in the afternoon he swims in the sea to further prepare for the upcoming trip. "I don't like the rules and swimming in open water is a way of expressing myself, I can call it a form of rebellion. I don't feel trapped and that gives a feeling of freedom. At the same time it gives you a feeling that you are flying above the marine world, which also gives it an extra dimension." In early October he made a practice swim in Aruba, 'Di punta pa punta', during which he traveled from Arashi Beach to Baby Beach swam, a distance of approximately 34 kilometers.

Coming home

Deaxo experienced the Crossing for Hope swim in 2018 in a daze: "Looking back, I experienced that day through other people's stories, I was

only busy swimming." It felt like a very short day to him, while the swim of about 30 kilometers took 10 hours and 40 minutes.

"Underwater you have no control over time and at that moment I wanted to be more with my own thoughts. Then it is a pity that it is over so quickly, now I would do it differently and I want to enjoy the whole process. I want to save moments, collect more memories instead of shutting myself off from the rest of the world." And will the upcoming swim be enough for Deaxo? "I can only say that when I land on Curaçao." The open water swimmer was inspired to do his own version of an 'Ocean7 challenge' where he swims the seven seas pilgrimage, but then along the islands, a kind of Caribbean pilgrimage. "I haven't decided what I'm looking for yet. It's an attraction I can't ignore, so I get carried away.

During such a swimming trip, boundaries become diluted and it is about reaching the goal. Coming ashore then immediately becomes coming home, whether that is on Curaçao, Bonaire or Aruba," says Deaxo.

Testing positive for Covid-19 while in Aruba

All visitors will be required to comply with the Government of Aruba procedures and protocols if showing symptoms and/or testing positive for COVID-19 while in Aruba. The mandatory requirements will include isolation, possible relocation and quarantine for close contacts.

The complete details can be found in the Isolation Protocol for Visitors (version 4) as published by the Department of Public Health (DVG).

Aruba Health & Happiness Code
